A step forward in Centre Hastings on the Clare McFaul Long Term Care Home.

CENTRE HASTINGS – A building permit has been issued to build a new long-term care home, Clare McFaul Long Term Care, in Centre Hastings.

The new facility will be a 128-bed LTC home in the Village of Madoc, Centre Hastings. The new single storey building will be located at 208 St Lawrence Street West.

“We have been working diligently and are very excited about the issuance of the building permit for this project,” said Centre Hastings Mayor Tom Deline.

Joseph Gulizia, President and CEO of UniversalCare Canada Inc. stated, “Our team wishes to thank staff and council at the Municipality of Centre Hastings for their relentless efforts and unwavering support in getting us to this stage.”

He added that: “We are grateful to the of Government of Ontario and particularly the Ministry of Long-Term Care for continuing to make seniors and long-term care a priority in our province,”

The project is anticipated to bring 130 jobs to the area and have a far-reaching economic impact on the region. UniversalCare Canada Inc. who will be managing the home is expecting to break ground in August 2023, with construction estimated to be completed by the end of March 2025.

Joseph Gulizia added, “we are actively working through the stages of development to make this home a reality in the Village of Madoc, Centre Hastings.”

The total construction value of the building permit issued is \$33,898,000.
