Clare McFaul Long Term Care Home Tender for Construction Issued

CENTRE HASTINGS – A tender for the construction of the Clare McFaul Long Term Care Home, in Centre Hastings has been issued by UniversalCare Canada Inc. on biddingo.com

The new facility will be a 128 bed LTC home in the village of Madoc, Centre Hastings. The new single-story building will be located at 208 St. Lawrence Street West.

“On behalf of myself and Council we are very excited about this next step forward. We have been working hard as a community to support the LTC project.” said Centre Hastings Mayor Tom Deline.

Joseph Gulizia, President and CEO of UniversalCare Canada Inc stated, “We continue work diligently on this project. We would like to extend our sincerest gratitude to Centre Hastings staff who have been amazing throughout this process and the entire Council for having the vision to bring LTC into your community.”

He added that: “We are grateful to the Government of Ontario and particularly the Ministry of Long-Term Care for continuing to make seniors and long-term care a priority in the province.”
